

PLOT RESTORATION: "small project" size

3 men - 4 hrs. each= \$12 hours
x \$ 72 per hour

Total bid..... \$ 864.00

Suggestion: Major monuments, tall obelisks, heavy stones will require experienced men with equipment to raise and re-set the monuments.
