Union Cemetery: G.A.R. Plot Inscriptions in 1937

The following names were abstracted from a typed manuscript entitled: REDWOOD CITY CEMETERY, Redwood City, San Mateo County, California - Records taken August 1937 by La Puerta de Oro Chapter D.A.R.

From the manuscript's title, it is assumed that members of this D.A.R. chapter transcribed the existing stones at Union Cemetery in 1937 and then prepared an alphabetical listing of the stone inscriptions.

Notations were given if the stone was in the Masonic plot, the G.A.R. plot, the A.O.F. plot, or the Friends plot. There were no notations for the I.O.O.F. plot or the Redmen plot.

It is not known if the entire cemetery was walked and transcribed as no explanation of the project accompanies the typed index.

However, this manuscript is important as it documents the stones in existence in 1937 so that comparisons can be made to the stones existing in the cemetery today (1988), 51 years later.
