Redwood City April 25th 1881
Regular Annual Meeting of the Union Cemetery Association held pursuant

to the By laws and notice published.
Present George D. Rice President presiding
George W. Fox Secretary and Treasurer and
James Crow Superintendent

And a Quorum of Members
The minutes of former meetings were read
and approved.

The Annual report of the Superintendent
and of the Secretary and Treasurer were presented
read and approved.

On motion the Board of Directors were
Authorized to subdivide the larger lots lying between
the Central and Western Avenues and to sell
them entire or in subdivisions as purchasers
may desire and they shall deem to the best
interests of the Association.

After the discussion as to price of lots ordered that
the price of single burial lots be raised to \$15-
per lot, and that the price of all other lots be ad-
vanced twenty five per cent from this date.

Ordered that the Board of Directors make settle-
ment of the claim of Hedge & Singer for graveling
Western Avenue by paying them from the funds
now on hand \$42- and a Certificate or check bill
for \$100- payable from the first available funds.

Ordered that in cutting the grass in the Cemetery
for this season the Superintendent employ men to
cut and cure what is suitable for hay and to remove
all not suitable and that the hay be sold by
the Superintendent.

On Motion the Board were Authorized to permit the
transfer of burial Certificates for the lots now
owned by J. S. Spaulding and Mrs C. Harves.

An election being now held the present officers were re-elected
for another year.

will contract to and with Theodore Finger
to gravel said Avenues as above stated
at said rate and price of cents per
linear foot payable from and with
the first available funds - without interest
whereupon the Board adjourned

Superintendent James Crowe reported
that the contract with Theodore Finger
for gravelling Eustenek and Southern Avenues
had been completed according to contract
that the work measured feet and
that at the contract price there was due
Mr. Finger therefor the sum of two hun-
dred and twenty nine ^{and} dollars
whereupon it is ordered that the ~~Board~~ ^{Secretary}
President issue to Mr Finger a certifi-
cate of the Association for said sum of
money payable from the first available
funds without interest - which being
done the Board adjourned
