

Articles of Association
of the
Union Cemetery Association ✓
of
San Mateo County, California.

Adopted February 28th 1859 ✓

Article II. Name.

This Organization shall be known as the Union Cemetery Association of San Mateo County, in the State of California.

Article III. Object.

The sole and only object of this Association shall be the Purchase, support and maintenance of a Cemetery for the burial of the Dead.

Article IV. Officers.

Sec 1. The Officers of this Association shall be One President, One Secretary and Treasurer, and one Superintendent of Grounds, who shall be elected annually, and shall hold their respective offices until their successors are elected, and have entered upon the duties of the Office.

Sec 2. The election of Officers shall be by ballot, and a majority of all the votes cast at such election shall be required to constitute a choice.

Sec 3. Should a vacancy occur in any of said offices, the Association shall have power to fill such vacancy at any meeting of the Association, in the manner prescribed by section 2 of this Article.

Sec 4. The President shall preside at all meetings of the Association, and shall perform such other duties as may be required of him by these Articles, or by the By Laws of the Association. Should the President be absent from any meeting, the Superintendent shall act as President pro tem. and should there be any vacancy in the said Office of President, the Superintendent shall act as such until a successor is elected.

Sec 5. The Secretary and Treasurer shall, as Secretary keep true and faithful records of the proceedings of the Association, and of all transactions of its Board of Directors, and shall as Treasurer receive and safely keep all monies of the Association.
