

4-26-1880 ^{bill for} ~~payment of~~ 20 from S. B. Gilbert for surveying done of the ash grounds.

1881 - The Bd of Dir were authorized to subdivide the ~~large~~ lots lying between Central & Western Ave and to run them entire or in subdivision as preferred by desires.

1886 - all lots lying west of Central Avenue were to be subdivided & to fix the prices of all such lots & to make provision for water for the use of lot owners.

1887 - J. S. Hughes raised \$400⁰⁵ to install water. He laid pipe & put in a water & water was already in use at expense of \$416.67

1888 - Mr. Hughes authorized to purchase 1000' of 1" pipe + 400' 1/2" pipe & 72 small sprinklers. Hughes apptd suptdt of water works, & to collect payment for water use, to set water rates etc.

1889 - Crows reported 23 buries

1890 - Owen Mc Garvey hired to gravel the drive thru the center of the cemetery. ~~Thence S. to the south line of the cem & Thence~~ West to the north line & to have back to the entrance. Grave to be 8 feet wide & 9" deep in the center

1891 - to date 20 buries

1893 - 32

1868 - Turner sept. refused to turn over the books to his successor. Curtis Baird.

1869 - Curtis Baird was sept.

1872 - voted to prepare a new survey & plot to be made of the SE half of the grounds.

April 1873 - voted to fix the plan of the lots of the new survey of the Eastern half of the cemetery.

1876 - voted to purchase a ^{book} burial register ~~book~~ to properly keep the records of the burials in proper form.
voted to properly grade the avenue.
~~voted to~~ directed sept to round out the corners of lots of ^{avenue} so vehicles could operate on the avenue.

1877 April James Crowe nominated to be sept.

1877 - they paid. H. A. Seaford for transferring the old burial records into the "new" burial register.
