RC STD Thurs Aug 15, 1929:

"Charles Kreiss, wellknown pioneer resident of RC, passed away at his home on Shasta street, last Saturday, following an illness of several months. He was 69 years of age. Born in Sacramento, he came to RC with his parents when he was a boy 8 years old, and had made his home here ever since. He had resided on Shasta street formerly Cooper street, for 61 consecutive years. His parents were Michael and Josephine Kreiss, pioneers of the State. The father built and operated for many years the old Pioneer Brewery on El Camino Real at the Five Points. Part of the old building is still standing and is one of the landmarks of the city. The deceased conducted a soda water manufacturing business in RC for a number of years, and also engaged in the hotel business at Woodside. Late he farmed for a time. He retired from active business about 15 years ago. Mr. Kreiss is survived by his widow, Mrs Mary Kreiss and three daughters, Mrs Josie Waibel of Oakland, Mrs Ruoy Sanderson of Ventura, and Mrs Lawina Pence of Los Angeles.
